

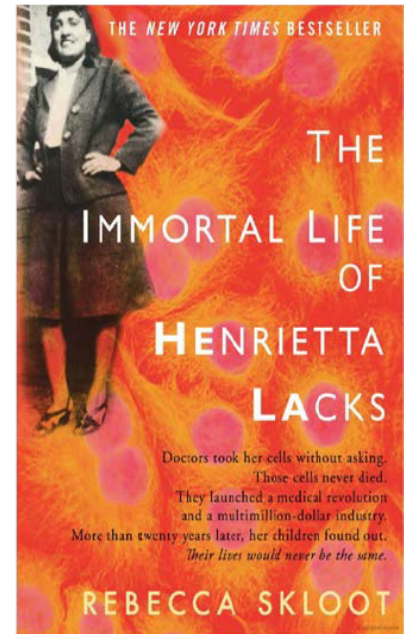

Objectives
